



Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of early childhood education settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children's wellbeing, learning and development. Depending on the setting, educators may work under direct supervision or autonomously.

Course Duration

The course is usually conducted over 18 weeks. Training comprises of 2 days per week using the classroom, simulated environments and situations, and requires 120 hours of work placement and be able to obtain a 'Working with Children' check (Blue Card) with an Early Childhood Education and Care Centre. Work placement is usually conducted over a 4 week period. The MaraWay Training will provide you with assistance to gain your work placement.
