



Course Overview

Now is a great time to join the Aged Care and Disability sector.

Over the next 25 years, the population of people 65 years or older is expected to double. Additionally, the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) will be rolled out and is expected to create significant employment opportunities.

The CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing or Disability) course is a nationally recognised qualification providing you with the skill set and knowledge to gain entry level employment into this dynamic, growing industry.

The qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and / or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgment in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs.

Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concept and practices required to provide person-centred support.

The course structure at The MaraWay Training is flexible so you can choose to specialise in Ageing or Disability... or both.

The first 9 units are common units in both qualifications. You then choose either 4 Ageing or 4 Disability elective units to complete your qualification.

And if you are lucky enough to have already completed one of the qualifications, you can simply complete 4 units in the other specialisation and gain an additional certificate. Call The MaraWay Training now and take your career to a new level.

Course Duration

The course will run over 14 weeks, two days per week.

Training comprises of using the classroom, simulated environments and situations, and requires 120 hours of work placement with a Disability or Aged Care Service Provider.

Work placement is usually conducted over a 4 week period. The MaraWay Training will provide you with assistance to gain your work placement.

Career Pathways

Career pathways in the aged care or disability sectors are varied and can include: Support Workers; Personal Care Workers; Therapists and Therapy Assistants; Business Support Staff; Home and Community Workers; and Personal Assistants. A care worker will generally help people who are ageing (with disability) or have a mental, physical or intellectual disability. They provide support in many ways. In essence, they will help others improve their quality of life and wellbeing.

What will it cost?

Additional to the course fee (if applicable) a separate Administration Fee of \$20 is charged to each student to pay for an Australian National Police Check.
