



Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of early childhood educators who are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum in early childhood education and care services. In doing so they work to implement an approved learning framework within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They may have responsibility for supervision of volunteers or other staff.

Course Duration

The course is usually conducted over 52 weeks. Training comprises of one evening plus one day per week, face to face in our classroom using simulated environments and situations. Course work is completed online whilst in the classroom and requires 240 hours of work placement throughout the duration of the course. All students will need to hold a Blue Card prior to starting their practical work placement. At The MaraWay, we will provide you with assistance to gain your work placement.

Registered Training Organisation (RTO)

This course is offered by CQUniversity, RTO 40939. The MaraWay will conduct training, assessment and recruitment on behalf of CQUniversity. CQUniversity is responsible for issuance of qualifications.
